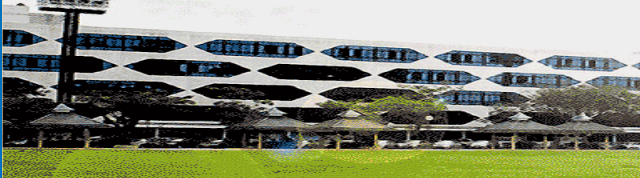


International Exchange Program Fact Sheet 2013 – 2014

Application Deadlines:

- 1 May** for Fall semester.
- 1 October** for Spring semester.

Required Documents:

- Exchange application form (available online) : <http://app.bus.tu.ac.th/inter>
- Course selection form
- Copy of passport
- Copy of official transcripts
- TOEFL/IELTS score for non-native speakers or approval by home institution
- Housing and arrival form

Language requirement:

TOEFL 550 / IELTS 6.0 for non-native English speakers or approval from home institution

Learning Expectations:

- Class Format: case studies, discussions, student projects, tutorial sessions and lectures.
- Class participation affects the student's final grade in most courses. Students are required to have a minimum of 80% class attendance.

Language of Instruction:

100% on international programs courses offered to exchange students are in English.

Exams:

Exam dates are to be announced by respected programs. Exchange students are required to participate in minimum 80% of the classes to be eligible for the final exams, mostly written ones.

Full-time Workload:

Undergraduate Level

- Maximum 6 courses (TBS 18 credits) per semester
- 3 credits equal to 3 class hours per course per week
- Approx. 16 weeks per semester

Graduate Level

- Maximum 8 courses but not over TBS 12 credits per semester
- 3 credits equal to 3 class hours per course per week
- Approx. 16 weeks per semester (excluding MIM Program which run one course at a time)

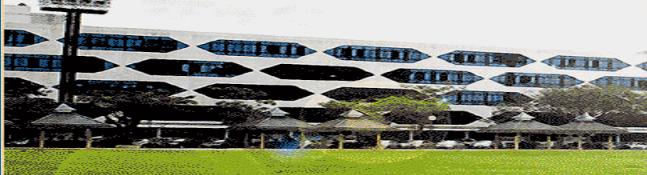

(dates vary among each program of studies)

Orientation for International Students 2013: January

Registration: First two weeks of semester.

Visa:

Exchange students will have to apply for the “**Non-Immigrant ED Visa**” at the nearby Royal Thai Embassy to enter Thailand.

Expenses:

- Living Expense:** **Housing:** (Approx.) USD 170 – 700 per month
(only off-campus accommodation available)
- Academic Expenses:** **Book and course materials:** USD 150 per semester
- Other Expenses:** **Meals:** USD 200 per month
Entertainment: USD 100 – 200 per month
Transport: USD 90 – 150 per month
****1 USD = 31 Baht (as of October 2012)**
